

# Ellen White Statements on Three Persons in the Godhead

The following is a compilation of statements that Ellen White made in reference to the three persons of the Godhead. As you read through these very clear statements, notice that she refers to these individuals as "persons", "powers", "authorities", "representatives", "agencies", "characters", "dignitaries", "instrumentalities", "Worthies", and "beings". This should leave no doubt that Ellen White considered each member of the Godhead to be a distinct, individual person or being, and that she considered them to be equal in their eternal existence, infinite power, and authority.
